From the valid applications received by the deadline, the Swine Week student chairs will research all qualified organizations and will select 3-5 organizations as finalists to make a presentation to the Swine Week student chairs and advisor. After the presentations from the finalists, the Swine Week student chairs will select 2-3 organizations to make a second presentation to the entire Edmond Memorial Student Council. Each finalist organization can bring up to 5 presenters, and each is encouraged to bring visuals, handouts, supplementary information, etc. to help the 30-35 Student Council members learn more about you. (Please do not bring food, drinks or gifts of any value without receiving permission in advance.)

The Swine Week recipient will be chosen by the EMHS Student Council after all presentations are complete. The selected organization will be notified on or before October 14th. At that time, additional meetings will be scheduled. The selected organization must be willing to receive considerable media attention and provide press quotes, interviews, logos, photos, videos, as well as personal stories from staff, volunteers and clients (see attached sample contract). The organization must also provide a presence or representative at all Swine Week events, make speeches at assemblies, and assist with promotion when possible. Swine Week will be held March 11-15, 2024.
